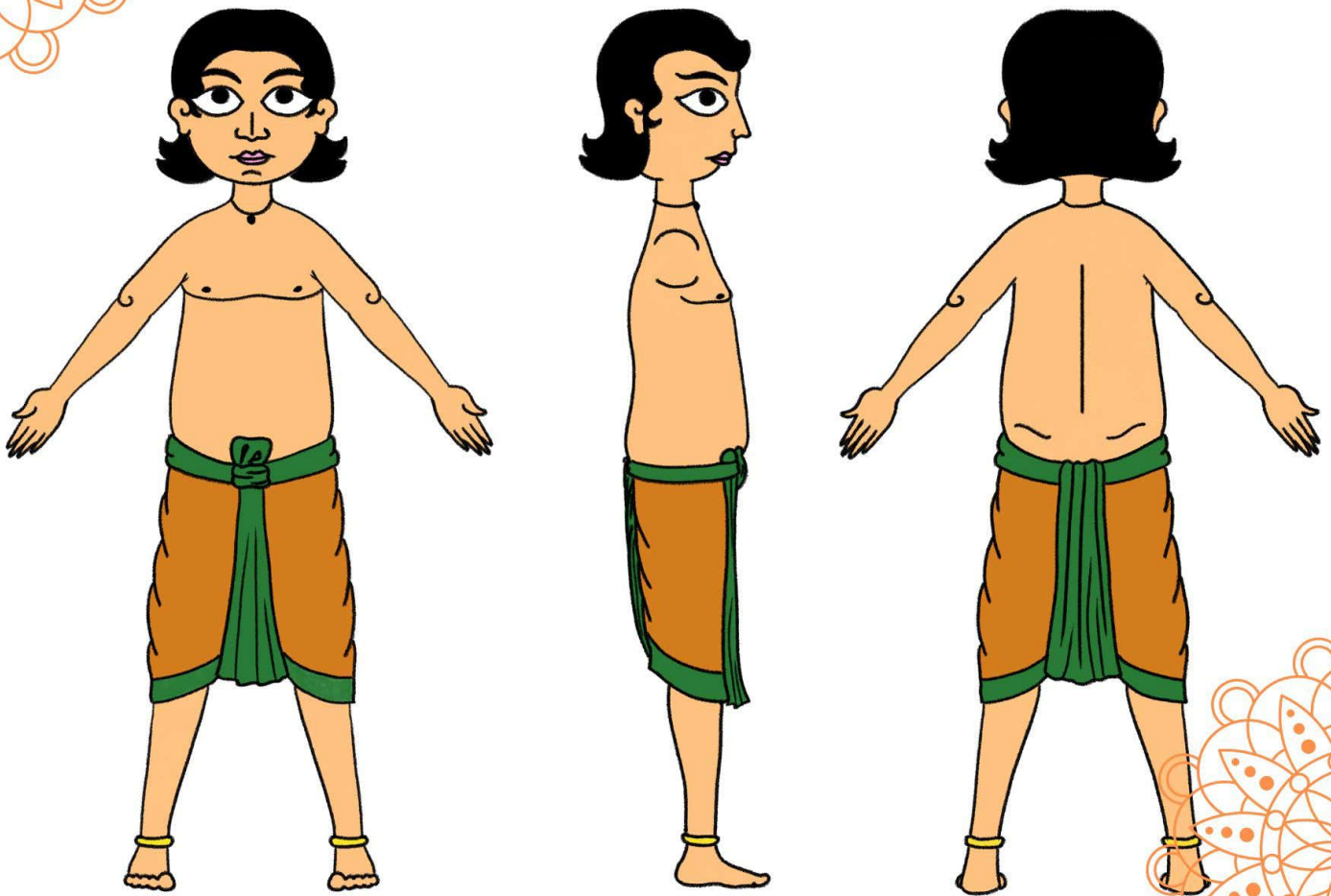

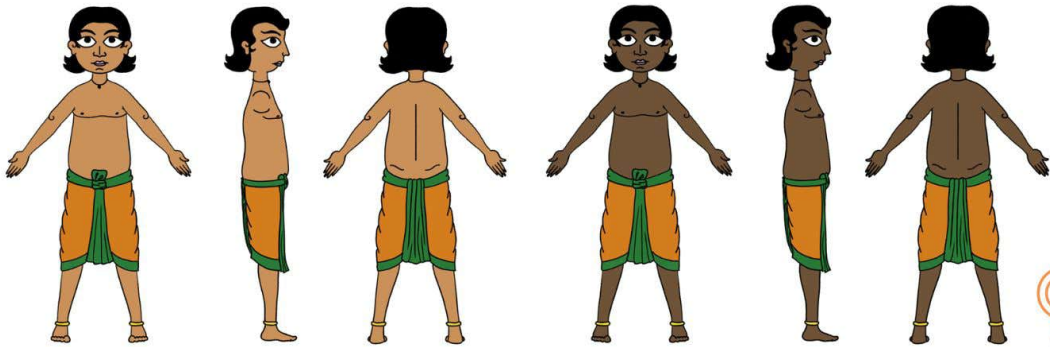
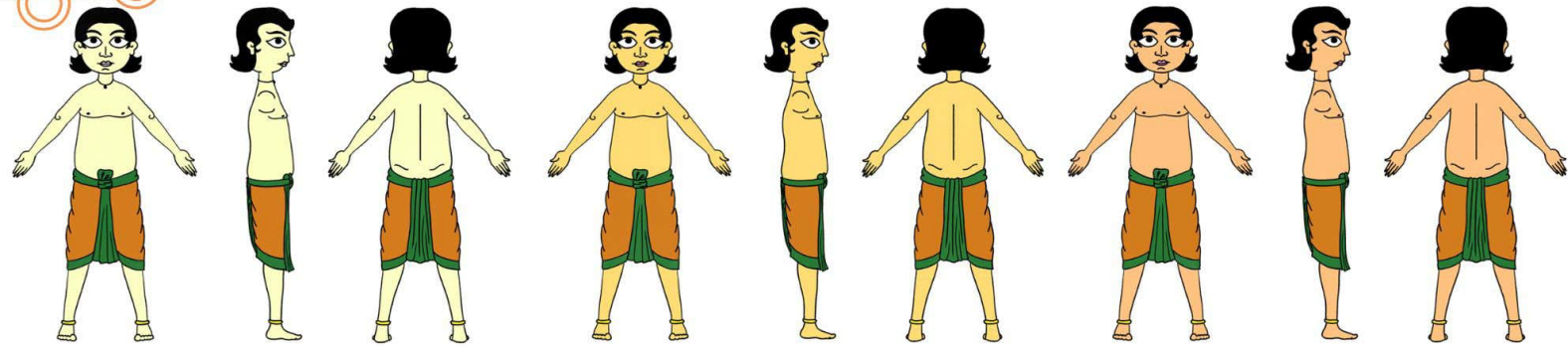
- **Analysis of character:** Jyot is a pre teen human character

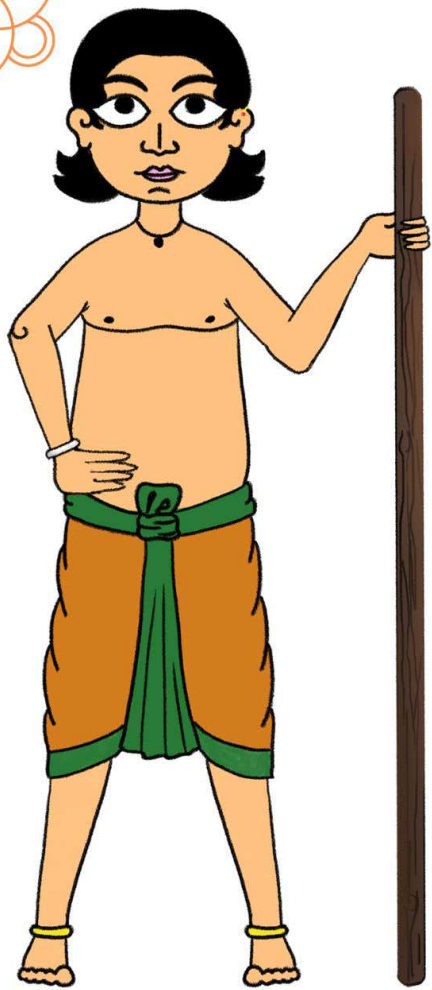
Shape Breakdown



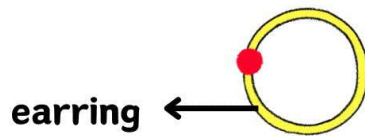
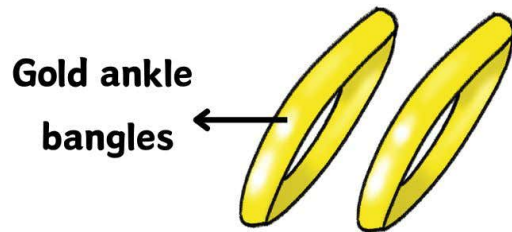
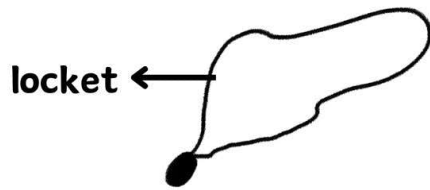
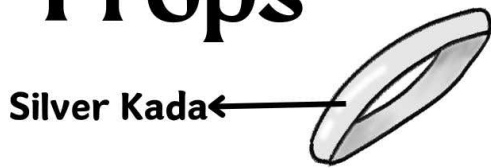
The character is fully made of geometric shapes like circle, triangles, rectangles & trapeziums.

Most of the body is made of ellipses & rectangle. The circle represent soft side of the character & the rectangles represent the strength and power.



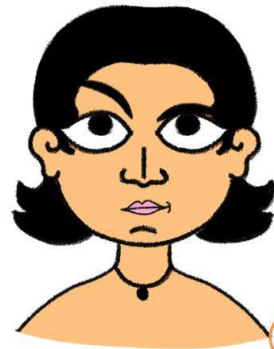
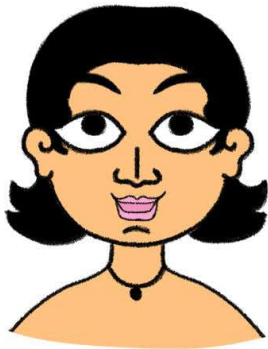
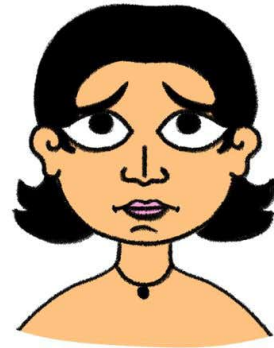
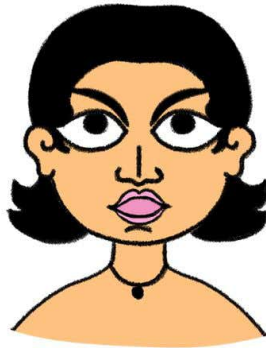
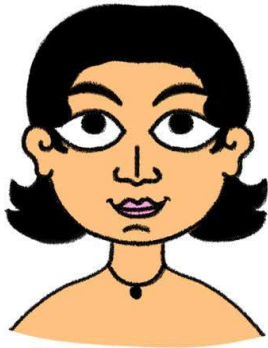
